Per your letter of April 18, 2000, we have reviewed the Town of Farmersville proposed Local Law # 1 of 2000 relating to Solid Waste Disposal.

Our counsel's office has determined that under the authority of Town Law §130(6) and the Municipal Home Rule Law §10(2) the Town is authorized to adopt such a local law. However, we do note the fee schedule which has been developed (permit fees and royalty fees) and caution that such fees must bear a reasonable relationship to the cost of administering the permit(s) and may not (legally) simply be used as a revenue producing measure for the community.

We therefore suggest that the local law include a section which analyses the costs related to administering the provisions of the local law and how that bears a reasonable relationship to the fees being charged.
